



## SUMMER CAMP WEEKLY SCHEDULE

*Glazed and Confused is following the guidelines set forth by the American Camp Associations' Guidelines for camps during COVID-19, the CDC, and St. Louis County Department of Public Health. Camp is monitored by our Studio Manager, Becky who is also BLS Certified. All sessions have five campers at the maximum. Some programming may change based on the materials available at the time of camp.*

### MONDAYS

9:30 or 1:30

Campers will arrive. Parents/caretakers will pay any remaining camp balances, confirm emergency contact information, and discuss any special circumstances for their child/children. Parents/caretakers will also give t-shirt size of their child/children for tie-dyeing later in the week.

9:30-9:45 or 1:30-1:45

Campers meet with their camp counselor. The campers will each be given their own bin with their own supplies they will be using throughout the week.

9:45-10:45 or 1:45 to 2:45

The campers will pour their first pottery molds. Later in the week when the molds dry, they will learn how to clean the molds and see them get fired in the kiln and paint them. Camper choose a piece of pottery in the studio (\$18 and under) and paint their piece.

10:45-11:00 or 2:45-3:00

Snack Break.

11:00-11:30 or 3:00-3:30

The campers will work on a watercolor project or an outside chalk drawing.

11:30-12:15 or 3:30 to 4:15

The campers will remove their greenware from the molds (if they are dry enough), or work on a craft project.

12:15-12:30 or 4:15 to 4:30

Clean up and pick up.

## TUESDAYS

9:30 or 1:30

Campers Arrive. The campers should be wearing old clothes this day, as we will be working with acrylic paints.

9:30-9:45 or 1:30-1:45

Campers will glaze their pottery that they painted the day before.

9:45-10:45 or 1:45 to 2:45

The campers will learn how to stretch and make their own canvas for canvas painting. We will also apply our first coats of gesso.

10:45-11:00 or 2:45-3:00

Snack Break.

11:00-11:30 or 3:00-3:30

The campers will work on a camp project such as beading or bracelet making if the gesso is not dry.

11:30-12:15 or 3:30 to 4:15

The campers will work on their canvas paintings.

12:15-12:30 or 4:15 to 4:30

Clean up and pick up.

## WEDSDAYS

9:30 or 1:30

Campers Arrive.

9:30-10:00 or 1:30-2:00

Campers will clean the molds they poured earlier in the week (if dry); Campers will load the pottery and greenware into the kiln, under G and C staff supervision.

10:00-10:45 or 2:00 to 2:45

Reverse colander pours on canvas and a craft activity.

10:45-11:00 or 2:45-3:00

Snack Break.

11:00-11:30 or 3:00-3:30

The campers will begin working on their *papier maché* sculpture.

11:30-12:15 or 3:30 to 4:15

The campers will continue work on their *papier maché* sculpture or begin a new craft activity.

12:15-12:30 or 4:15 to 4:30

Clean up and pick up.

## THURSDAYS

9:30 or 1:30

Campers Arrive. The campers should be wearing old clothes this as we will be tie-dyeing outdoors (weather permitting).

9:30-9:45 or 1:30-1:45

The campers will open the kiln under staff supervision to see their glazed pottery pieces and their cleaned molds (bisque).

9:45-10:15 or 1:45 to 2:15

The campers will use tie dye to design their t-shirt.

10:15-10:45 or 2:15 to 2:45

The campers will begin painting their bisque.

10:45-11:00 or 2:45-3:00

Snack Break.

11:30-12:15 or 3:30 to 4:15

The campers will work on their *papier maché* sculptures or begin a new craft activity.

12:15-12:30 or 4:15 to 4:30

Clean up and pick up.

## FRIDAYS

9:30 or 1:30

Campers arrive.

9:30-9:45 or 1:30-1:45

The campers will remove the rubber bands from their t-shirts and put them out to dry. Parents will be given aftercare instructions for the t-shirts.

9:45-10:00 or 1:45 to 2:00

The campers will glaze their bisque pieces they poured. These pieces will be ready for pick up the Tuesday after the camp session ends. G and C staff will contact parents/caretakers when they are ready for pick up.

10:00-10:45 or 2:00 to 2:45

The campers will finish any projects they were not able to finish during the week or begin a new craft activity.

10:45-11:00 or 2:45-3:00

Snack Break.

11:30-12:15 or 3:30 to 3:15

The campers will work on "The Ultimate 3-D Canvas" challenge and apply their handprints to a larger canvas to be displayed in the studio.

12:15-12:30 or 4:15 to 4:30

Clean up and pick up.
