



SUMMER ART CAMP ITINERARY--2021

MONDAY

9:30 or 1:30

Campers arrive. Parents/caretakers will pay any remaining camp balances, confirm emergency contact information, and discuss any special circumstances for their child/children. Parents/caretakers will also give t-shirt or short size of their child/children for tie-dyeing later in the week.

9:30-9:45 or 1:30-1:45

Campers meet with their camp counselor. The campers will each be given their own bin with their own supplies they will be using throughout the week. We will begin with a "warm up" activity.

9:45-10:45 or 1:45-2:45

The campers will pour their first pottery molds. Later in the week when the molds dry, they will learn how to clean the molds and see them get fired in the kiln and paint them. Campers choose a piece of pottery in the studio (\$19 and under) and paint their piece.

10:45-11:00 or 2:45-3:00

Snack Break.

11:00-12:00 or 3:00-4:00

Campers will learn how to make Tempera Paint using eggs and natural pigments. They will also begin their tempera paintings.

12:00-12:15 or 4:00-4:15

The campers will remove their greenware from the molds (if they are dry enough), or work on a craft project.

12:15-12:30 or 4:15-4:30

Clean up and pick up.

TUESDAY

9:30 or 1:30

Campers Arrive.

9:30-9:45 or 1:30-1:45

Warm Up Activity.

9:45-10:30 or 1:45-2:30

The campers will learn how to stretch and make their own canvas for canvas painting. We will also apply our first coats of gesso.

10:30-10:45 or 2:30-2:45

The campers will dip their pottery into the glaze (under counselor supervision)

10:45-11:00 or 2:45-3:00

Snack Break.

11:00-11:30 or 3:00-3:30

Campers will learn how to make their own slime.

11:30-12:15 or 3:30-4:45

Campers will paint containers to hold their new art supplies in.

12:15-12:30 or 4:15-4:30

Clean up and pick up.

WEDNESDAY

Campers Arrive.

9:30-9:45 or 1:30-1:45

Warm Up Activity

9:45-10:45 or 1:45-2:45

Campers will clean the molds they poured earlier in the week (if dry); Campers will load the pottery and greenware into the kiln, under G and C staff supervision.

10:45-11:00 or 2:45-3:00

Snack Break.

11:00-11:45 or 3:00 to 3:45

Campers will work on their acrylic canvas paintings.

11:45-12:15 or 3:45 to 4:15

Campers will learn how to marble on pottery.

12:15-12:30 or 4:15-4:30

Clean up and pick up.

THURSDAY

Campers Arrive.

9:30-9:45 or 1:30-1:45

The campers will open the kiln under staff supervision to see their glazed pottery pieces and their cleaned molds (bisque).

9:45-10:15 or 1:45 to 2:15

The campers will complete their tie dye project.

10:15-10:45 or 2:45-3:00

The campers will begin painting their bisque.

10:45-11:00 or 3:00-3:45

Snack Break.

11:15-12:15 or 3:45 to 4:15

Printmaking with sink mats and other textured surfaces.

12:15-12:30 or 4:15-4:30

Clean up and pick up.

FRIDAY

9:30 or 1:30

Campers arrive.

9:30-9:45 or 1:30 to 1:45

The campers will remove the rubber bands from their t-shirts and put them out to dry. Parents will be given aftercare instructions their tie dye projects

9:45-10:00 or 1:45 to 2:00

The campers will glaze their bisque pieces they poured. These pieces will be ready for pick up the Tuesday after the camp session ends. G and C staff will contact parents/caretakers when they are ready for pick up.

10:00-10:45 or 2:00-2:45

The campers will finish any projects they were not able to finish during the week or begin a new craft activity.

Camper free time and putting handprints on a canvas to be displayed in the rest of the studio.
